SWEET DeCarbCH Networking Conference 2025

DeCarbCH is a research project sponsored by the Swiss Federal Office of Energy's "SWEET" programme (Call 1-2020) and coordinated by the University of Geneva.

The DeCarbCH project addresses the colossal challenge of **decarbonisation of heating and cooling in Switzerland** within three decades and it prepares the grounds for negative CO₂ emissions.

This year annual conference is special as it represents the end of phase I one and many work packages and the beginning of phase II. It will be an occasion to **present** the research ongoing within the SWEET DeCarbCH project in more detail but even more importantly to share knowledge and to exchange with the DeCarbCH cooperation partners about the real problems and issues that are currently impeding the smooth and rapid decarbonisation of heating and cooling in the various sectors.


A word from the DeCarbCH Management team






